



Thank you for your recent course registration. The venue for the seminar is North Shore Private Hospital, Westbourne Street, St Leonards NSW. Please see the map below and follow this link for a map of the venue <https://goo.gl/maps/pz181q1npCz>

North Shore Private Hospital is located on Sydney's lower North Shore, adjacent to Royal North Shore Hospital. It is a ten minute walk to St Leonards Train Station. Regular buses run along the Pacific Highway, which is a five minute walk from the hospital, with the 144 Manly to Chatswood service stopping inside the RNSH/NSPH hospital campus.

Parking is available in the multi-storey car park, which is owned and operated by Wilson Parking. Parking fees are displayed at all entrances to the car park and Wilson also offers a discounted multi-day pass for \$35 (subject to change). We suggest parking in the P1 section as it has a covered walkway to the hospital.

Registration on day one will take place between 8.15am and 8.45am to allow the program to start promptly at 9am. At registration you will be given a workbook of lecture outlines with references and a four colour pen to aid note and diagram taking.

While attending the course you will be required to wear a name tag (supplied) to allow the hospital staff to identify our group for catering purposes, especially at lunch. This also makes it easy to remember the names of people you are meeting for the first time at the course. As you will be in an air-conditioned venue, we suggest that you dress in layers for comfort.
